Terms and Conditions -

1. Eligibility Criteria:

- Applicants must be Indian citizens.
- Applicants must be between the ages of 21 and 32 as of the application deadline.
- Applicants must possess a bachelor's degree from a recognized university or final year
- Applicants must demonstrate a strong commitment to public service and a desire to pursue a career in the civil services.

2. Application Process:

- All applications must be submitted through the official PM IAS UPSC Scholarship Program website.
- Applicants must complete the online application form and provide accurate and truthful information.
- Along with the application form, applicants must submit the required documents, including academic transcripts, proof of age, and a statement of purpose outlining their aspirations and commitment to public service.

3. Selection Process:

- Applications will be reviewed by a selection committee comprised of experts and stakeholders.
- Shortlisted candidates will be invited for an interview round to assess their suitability for the scholarship program.
- Final selection will be based on academic merit, financial need, commitment to public service, and performance in the interview round.

4. Scholarship Benefits:

- Scholarship recipients will receive financial assistance to cover expenses related to UPSC exam preparation, coaching fees only, [study materials, test Series and living expenses extra]
- Recipients will also have access to expert mentorship, personalized study plans, and community support to enhance their preparation journey.

5. Duration of Scholarship:

- The PM IAS UPSC Scholarship Program provides support for the duration of the recipient's UPSC exam preparation, up to a maximum period determined by the program administrators.
- After the commencement of the results, student must enrol in to the course by paying the minimal confirmation amount with in 3 days.

6. Termination of Scholarship:

- The scholarship may be terminated if the recipient fails to comply with the terms and conditions outlined herein or engages in any behavior deemed detrimental to the objectives of the program.
- The scholarship may also be terminated if the recipient withdraws from the UPSC exam preparation or fails to make satisfactory progress as determined by the program administrators.
